- a. For the category Healthcare Leader of the Year: The individual applying for the awards must be a founder, co-founder, owner, or a prominent leader in the healthcare industry, including CEOs, managing directors, or individuals holding key leadership positions.
- b. They must have held a senior leadership role (MD/CEO/Founder equivalent) with their current organization for a minimum of 2 years as of March 31, 2025.
- For Start Up of the Year
- a. The participating entity must be less than 10 years old from the date of incorporation, with an annual turnover not exceeding INR 100 crore in any financial year since its inception.
- b. Additionally, the startup must have DPIIT certificate.
- For Excellence in Multi Location Healthcare Delivery The healthcare chains should have a
 presence in more than 2 states or operating more than 2 hospitals/diagnostic centres in a
 single state
- For Multi-speciality Hospital of the Year The hospitals should have more than three specialties with advanced medical care and specialized treatment offerings.
